A. Review of H80-2025-Main Grant (Colleen Fisher)

Ms. Fisher presented the first-quarter reports to the committee. She explained that these funds were only used for staff salaries and related expenses. The committee did not have any questions or comments.

B. Review of H80-2024 UDS + Funding (Jennifer Harris)

Ms. Fisher stated that the UDS + is tied to the main grant. Ms. Harris stated that the UDS+ funds are set to expire on May 31, 2025. She expressed concerns surrounding the UDS+ funding and the new administration, which stopped the submission of UDS+ data for 2025, and in fact, dissolved the government staff that were working on the UDS+ project. At this point in time, the future of UDS+ is unknown. Ms. Harris also stated that this funding has been a challenge to spend and stay within the guidelines of the grant. She informed the committee that she expects to have some funds remaining at the close of the funding period and that HRSA is not offering a no-cost extension for the UDS+ funds.

C. Review of C8ECS44663- Capital Improvement (Jennifer Harris)

Ms. Harris gave the committee an update on the new mobile medical unit that is due to be delivered in approximately 3-4 weeks. The committee did not have any additional questions or comments.

D. Review of Screen Up Project (Jennifer Harris)

Ms. Fisher reviewed the expenses related to the Screen Up Program. This funding is being used to assist in paying for and training an employee to do patient navigation, which consists of assisting patients with completing their ordered testing or referrals. The committee did not have any questions or comments.

E. Review of 1st Quarter Data (Jennifer Harris)

Ms. Harris presented a comparison of 1st quarter 2024 to 1st quarter 2025 data to the committee. Ms. Harris stated that 2025's data showed improvement over 2024's data in all areas.
