Item I. & II. Call to Order & Roll Call:

Call to Order and Roll Call - A Special meeting of the Financial Committee of the Board of Directors of Plaquemines Primary Care, Inc. was called to order by Kellen Fincher at 5:30 pm on March 26, 2026, at the Plaquemines Medical Center, 8692 Hwy 23, Belle Chasse, LA. Jennifer Harris conducted the customary roll call of the Board Members, as well as recorded and documented the minutes. The results were as follows:

Item III. Review And Approval of Current Agenda: (Kellen Fincher)

Item IV. New Business: (Kellen Fincher)

A. Review of H80-2025 4th Quarter (Colleen Fisher)

Ms. Fisher presented the first-quarter reports to the committee. She explained that these funds were only used for staff salaries and related expenses. The committee did not have any questions or comments.

B. Review of RHII 4th Quarter (Jennifer Harris/Colleen Fisher)

Ms. Fisher explained that this funding is used to support Dr. Eubanks' services and the supplies needed to offer same-day contraceptive services such as oral or injectable birth control, implants, and IUDs. The committee discussed this, and there were no additional questions or comments.

C. Review of Screen-Up 2025-2026 (Jennifer Harris)

Ms. Harris states that PPC has been awarded \$10,000 for this grant cycle. Ms. Harris stated that no funding has been received yet for this funding period, but data for December through February is due on Friday, March 27th. She has also submitted an invoice for these months as well. Ms. Harris explained that the funds would be divided into three payments to cover a portion of the patient navigator's wages. The committee did not have any questions or comments.

D. Review of 4th Quarter Data (Jennifer Harris)

Ms. Harris explained that this is a review of 2025's data, which was pulled and compared with 2024. She explained that the year-to-date charges in 2025 were up by approximately \$250,000, and the adjustments also increased by approximately \$108,000. Collections increased by \$112,000 in 2025 compared to 2024. The outstanding AR was about \$18,000 more in 2025 than in 2024. Year-to-date visits were up 138 in 2025. The goal for 2025 was 463 visits per month, but the final count was 457.67. The net income goal was set at \$121.36, which was surpassed by \$31 per visit; gross collections were slightly under the goal of 60% per visit.

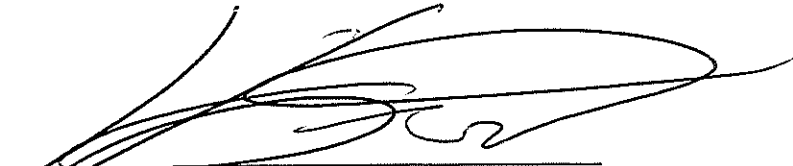
